The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;

3. Review and approval of the minutes of the May 5, 2026, Board meeting;
4. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports and the payment of invoices presented;
5. Agency website and smart device application ("GoGov"), including procedures for review of content and posting of content to website and distribution via GoGov;
6. Discuss Agency needs for consultant services and potential revisions to roles and responsibilities of current consultants;
7. Discuss and approve updates to Agency communications procedures;
8. Creation of educational materials and approve expenditures related to same;
9. Upcoming community events and consider 2026 scheduling of same, including (i) potential Bridgeland vendor appreciation event, and (ii) educational safety event for Bridgeland residents regarding operation of micromobility devices;
10. Harris County Constable, Precinct 5 ("Precinct 5") law enforcement services within Bridgeland, including discussions regarding the operation of micromobility devices within and outside of public road rights-of-way;
11. Administration of Flock license plate readers within Bridgeland;
12. Request from Records Management Officer to destroy certain records of the Agency;
